Education Services

We are focused on the construction and renovation of classrooms in rural Tanzania, which aims to expand access to education for hundreds of children in previously underserved areas. We are providing desks and essential learning materials to students, which will help reduce overcrowding and enhance the learning environment. Additionally, we are implementing school meal programs in partnership with local farmers. This initiative not only improves attendance rates but also boosts academic performance by addressing child nutrition.

Health Services

Construction of a maternity wing at rural health centres, providing expectant mothers with safer childbirth and reducing maternal and infant mortality rates. Supply of modern medical equipment to healthcare facilities, enhancing access to quality healthcare.

Water and Sanitation

Installation of boreholes and water storage systems ensures rural residents have access to clean water, thereby improving health services. Community sanitation initiatives have resulted in the construction of over 100 latrines and a significant reduction in waterborne diseases.

Women and Youth Employment

Training programs in Mwanza have empowered over 500 women with skills in tailoring, entrepreneurship, and market access, enabling them to establish successful businesses. Youth employment initiatives through providing vocational training in carpentry, welding, and agribusiness, preparing young people for self-reliant careers.



Modern Agricultural Practices

Introduction of innovative techniques like drip irrigation and conservation agriculture, leading to a 40% increase in crop yields for participating farmers. Training in pest management and organic farming practices to enhance harvest quality and market competitiveness.



Fish Farming and Processing

Modernizing fish farming techniques around Lake Victoria with training and equipment, helping local farmers increase their incomes by 50% on average.



Value Addition in Agriculture

Establishment of processing facilities to produce value-added products such as flour, creating new market opportunities and boosting profits for farmers.

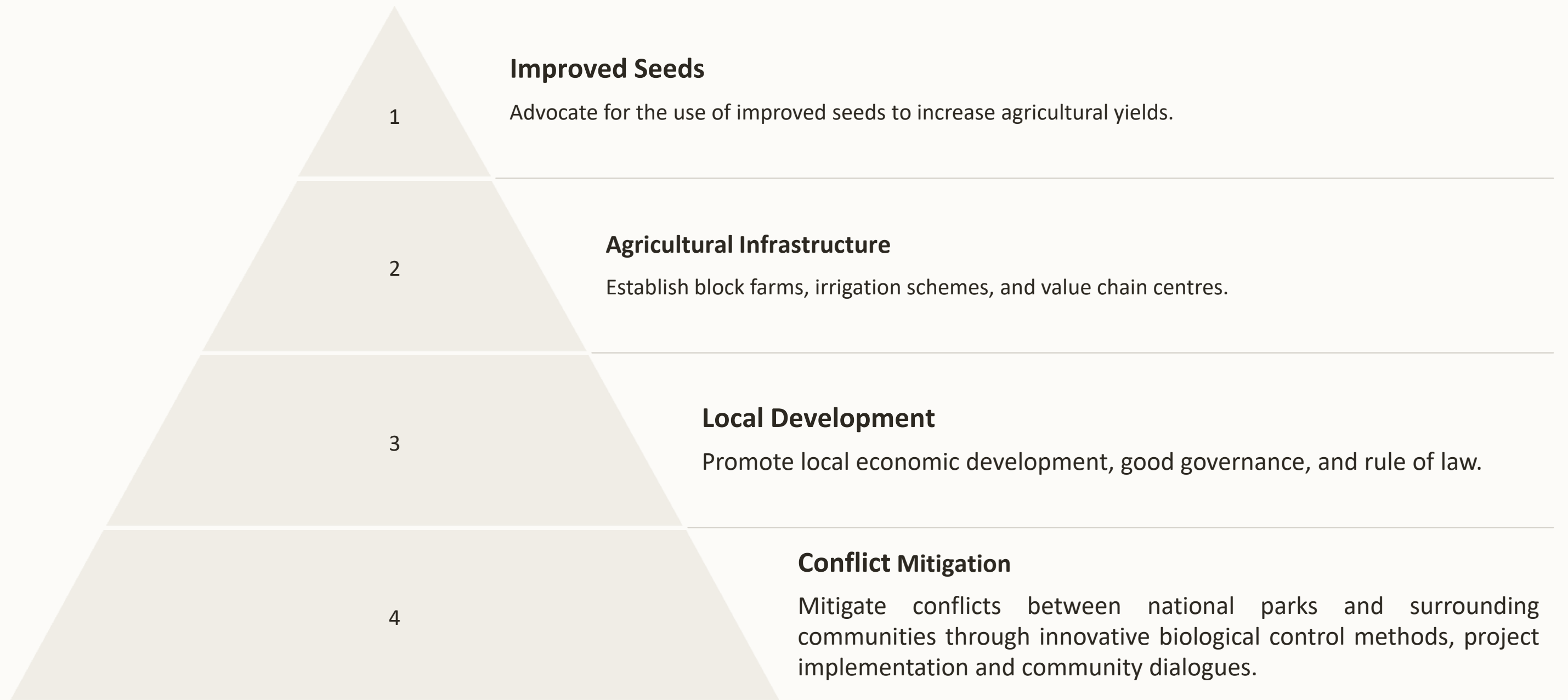
